Like you, the VMC Foundation had big plans for 2020. We were to relaunch foundations at O'Connor Hospital and St. Louise Regional Hospital, both now part of our local public system. We saw big opportunities to expand healthcare programs for homeless patients and looked forward to completing the Women and Children's Center at SCVMC.

And then COVID-19 hit. Just like you, our world turned upside down. Nearly overnight, we became a relief organization, charged with finding resources to protect healthcare workers and beat back the disease. The response was overwhelming. Over 5 million items of protective gear were donated by the community, giving local hospitals the supplies they needed. Millions of dollars were also contributed, allowing the VMC Foundation to purchase medical equipment and technology for rapid testing, telehealth, and — finally — vaccinations.

A year later, we had cause for optimism, both for ending the pandemic and resuming our 2020 work. Then came the shocking news that our beloved President and Executive Director Chris Wilder suffered a major stroke. We suddenly knew that we would spend the rest of 2021 without him. Faced with the unimaginable, we came together as a board and staff and did what Chris would have done — lead with compassion, joy, and an unwavering commitment to the cause of high-quality healthcare for all. None of us got into this work because we thought it was going to be easy. As the saying goes, nothing worth doing ever is. After the hardest of years, we're ready to dig in again — for frontline workers fighting to end this pandemic, for our community battered by this dreadful disease, and for our leader, Edward Christopher Wilder, who now needs us all more than ever.

The communities hit hardest by COVID-19 are low-income, communities of color that face economic and racial discrimination in accessing adequate health services. The VMC Foundation has been proud to support efforts by SCVMC and the Public Health Department to proactively bring economic support and vaccines to these communities.

- Our work with the PEACE Partnership helped 590 underserved families in East San Jose with COVID-19 relief funds
- Supplied county mobile team with iPads and resources to go door-to-door to sign up residents in underserved communities with vaccine appointments
- Purchased Public Health "VaxMobile" to grow mobile vaccine program
- Giveaways to promote Latinx, LGBTQ+ and teenspecific vaccine clinics
- Funded multilingual pediatrics vaccine promotion campaign

Like a Multivitamin:


is a color installation by local artist Leah Rosenberg in the Women and Children's courtyard. Different palettes speak to the range of emotions that visitors may experience.




A Tribute to Chris Wilder


