

ARPA Childcare Expansion Grant Program Overview

- New Family Childcare Home (FCCH) Providers:
 - Eligible for a start-up grant up to \$50,000 for operations and/or minor repair.

- For providers who have been licensed two or more years:
 - Construction, renovations, or modernization repairs to increase or recover lost capacity: planning and pre-development costs, retrofitting to meet licensing requirements, physical renovations to increase licensed capacity, including plumbing and fixtures, playground upgrades, kitchen renovations, and other related costs.
 - **Operating costs**: such as three months of rent, mortgage, and/or insurance; up to 12 months of wages to hire new childcare staff; or other related supports.

The County of Santa Clara Childcare and Early Education Infrastructure (Expansion) Grant Program has allocated \$15 million of Federal Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds under the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) to support local childcare providers serving communities negatively impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic to open, reopen, or increase the total number of affordable childcare spaces. Childcare providers eligible for infrastructure funding may include Family Child Care Home (FCCH), center-based, and other community agencies. Priority will be given to childcare providers who meet select social equity criteria to serve communities in greatest need of childcare and to reflect the geographic and cultural diversity of Santa Clara County.

Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA) and Application Guidelines is expected to be released in mid-September 2023.


The Childcare Expansion Grant program is available to licensed Child Care Family Childcare Home Providers in Santa Clara County. Infrastructure support will focus on childcare facility supports that address either construction or operational needs and result in an increase in childcare capacity, including filling vacant enrollment spots. With a focus on social equity, this Grant Program, approved by the County of Santa Clara Board of Supervisors on February 28, 2023, will use \$15 million of Federal Coronavirus State, and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (SLFRF) under the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) to support local childcare providers serving communities negatively impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic to open, reopen, or increase the total number of affordable childcare spaces. Childcare providers eligible for infrastructure funding may include Family Child Care Home (FCCH), center-based, and other community agencies. Priority will be given to childcare providers who meet select equity criteria to serve communities in greatest need of childcare and to reflect the geographic and cultural diversity of Santa Clara County.



Construction Application




Projects must:

- Comply with local building regulations and with State childcare licensing requirements
- Be completed by December 2026
- Secure multiple bids for major projects



Funds can be used for **major** or **minor** construction projects. Examples include:

- Major accessory units, renovate existing space like garages, move walls
- Minor painting walls, kitchen/bathroom projects



Limited operational funds may support staffing costs during construction
